SCHOLARSHIPS

Impact Scholarships help offset the cost of annual scholarships. Gifts to Impact Scholarships are not invested; rather, 100% of your yearly pledge will directly benefit a student-athlete scholarship. In 2020, we projected about \$315,000 in gifts to Impact Scholarships. In 2021, we are projecting \$234,000, a decrease from last year. We need your help. RAISING UP LEADERS LIKE PINKE

Hunter J. Pinke Leadership Football Endowment

Hunter Pinke, '21, is a lifelong North Dakotan, a recent UND graduate and captain of the Fighting Hawks Football team. On December 27, 2019, Hunter was in a skiing accident that resulted in a spinal cord injury and a broken back, leaving him paralyzed from his chest down. After a time of rehabilitation in Colorado, Hunter returned to UND and graduated with a mechanical engineering degree. He was accepted into graduate school at the University of Arizona where he plans to compete in adaptive track and field.

Hunter's leadership extended beyond competition. On campus, he led the UND's Fellowship of Christian Athletes, in the community he dedicated 170+ hours of service to nonprofits and schools, and in the classroom he maintained a 3.5 grade point average. In 2020, Hunter was named UND's Male Unsung Hero and the Grand Forks Herald's Person of the Year. He also received the national 2021 Wilma Rudolph Student-Athlete Achievement Award.

In honor of Hunter, his family, in partnership with UND Alumni Association & Foundation and UND Football, established the Hunter J. Pinke Leadership Football Endowment. The endowment will support scholarships for UND Football players who have exhibited a similar attitude, speech and actions displayed by Hunter.

How do I build NDCC Priority Points?

NDCC Priority Points are built through **NDCC** Membership actions and involvement at UND (see chart above).

Do gift pledges or payment plans toward my NDCC membership affect my points?

Priority Points accumulate as gifts and payments are received, not at the time they are pledged.

What is the purpose of Priority Points Ranking?

Priority Points ranking allows for a systematic, orderly and equitable process to prioritize ticket requests, including season tickets, away game tickets, postseason tickets and other benefits. The higher your ranking, the higher priority is given to your ticket requests.

How do you determine my Priority Points Rank?

Your Priority Point rank is determined by the number of Priority Points you've earned. All **ND Champions Club** members are ranked 1 to 2,267 (1 being the highest ranking). The more Priority Points you have, the higher your rank. For example, a member with a rank of 100 has earned 2,900 Priority Points. A member with a rank of 400 has earned 1,030 Priority Points.

Duplicating permits is not allowed and will result in a loss of parking privileges and a \$300 fine. Lost or stolen permits can be replaced for \$300.




