Effort—a consistent competitive championship effort daily both on and off the floor

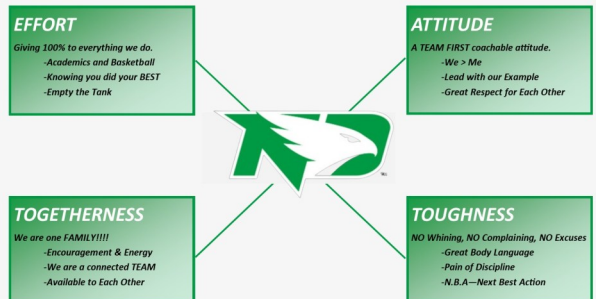
Attitude—a TEAM FIRST coachable attitude all the time
